- 2. Aggregate reports of findings from REQM evaluations are periodically requested by the IRB, Clinical Research Department, and Institutional Officials, with emphasis on evaluation of the overall effectiveness of the HRPP program and suggestions for educational improvement.

All evaluation findings are confidential and are not disclosed to entities outside of the Institution, unless necessary to disclose these findings as required by state or federal law.

Any concerns about the REQM should be directed to the Director of Research Integrity and Protection.
